 - c. Which factor do you think is the most influential for your character's decision-making process? What makes you say that?

2. What choices does your character face in this moment to take or not take certain actions? What will your character gain if they take action? What will they risk if they take action? What will your character lose if they don't take action?

3. How much agency does your character feel like they have in this moment?

4. What can you learn from the character's decision-making process or the text as a whole that can help you understand the relationship between someone's agency and their choice of action or inaction?
